








Décor H11 vs Contractor RCV 21

Advantages

Décor – Has more styles and options, Baseboard (2-“tubes”- high), Pedestal mount, Radiator style (3 to 11 tubes high), Vertical Style (tubes running vertically).

Contractor Series – Priced competitively, Two styles (RCV = horizontal “tube” look, similar to Décor) & (CV = vertical Euro-style front panel), bottom connections available – allows for easier rough-in (requires “HV-S or HV-A valve)
